| weed | Weeds are wild plants that grow in places people do not want them to |
| deciduous | A deciduous tree loses its leaves every year in winter |
| evergreen | An evergreen tree keeps its leaves all year round. |

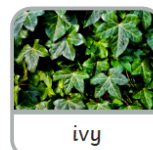

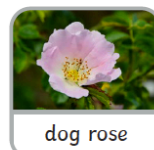

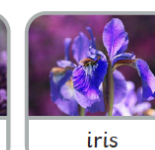
