

Maths

- *Number of the Week-looking at numbers 6-10
- *Daily subitising activities numbers 0-5
- *Understand position by words alone
- *Talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes, using informal and mathematical language
- *Talk about and identify the patterns around them

Understanding the World

- *Seven continents song
- *Photo of the day
- *Celebration Assembly (Tues pm)
- *Talk about the differences in materials, and changes they notice-
- *Explore different forces they can feel
- *Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things

Expressive Arts and Design

- *Singing assembly (Thurs pm)
- *Use their imagination as they consider what they can do with different materials
