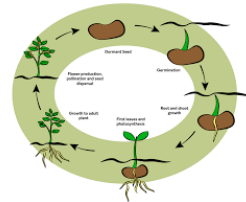
## Term 3: What in the World is Going on!

### Understanding the world

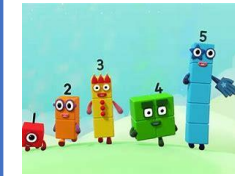
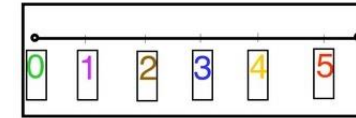
This half term we will be continuing to build routines and developing positive relationships with others.
