


Term 3: Once Upon a Time!

This half term we will be settling back into school routines, continuing to develop positive relationships with others.



We will be exploring the question “who eats porridge?”. Following this we will compare different traditional breakfast foods around the world.

As scientists, we will be looking at the life cycle of a beanstalk, shoots, roots and germination.




We will be also looking at different materials and their properties.
